Prep R: Jack H for having a positive attitude to learning.

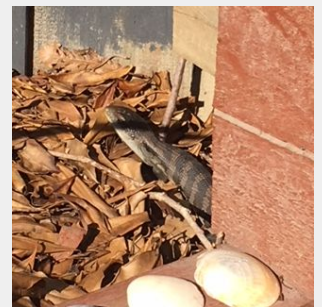
Reminders for the week:
