Writing

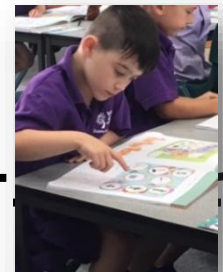
We will be learning about the Writer's Notebook and Independent Writing. What does this look like, sound like and feel like?
