



BEFORE AND AFTER SCHOOL SUPERVISION

PARENT NOTIFICATION

Supervision arrangements before and after school:

Student safety at Yarra Road Primary School is our highest priority and the safe and appropriate supervision of students is an important element of our duty of care to students. Part of this duty is ensuring parents and students are aware of our student supervision arrangements before and after school.

Before school: The Front and Back zones are supervised before school by rostered staff from 8:45 – 9:00 am. Upon arrival in the morning students are to make their way to the Front zone to await the 8:50 am bell which signals students to move to their class line up area, where teachers will meet them.

After school: The Front and Back zones are supervised after school by rostered staff from 3:30 until 3:45 pm.

Students on school grounds outside these times will **not** be supervised (unless they are attending a before or after school care program or supervised extracurricular activity).

Parents/carers are requested to ensure that students do not attend school outside of these supervised times unless they are attending before or after school care, or a pre-arranged supervised activity (i.e. sports practice).
